

\$25 Weekly Stimulus Payment

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The FAC program will phase out effective December 11, 2010. People who have been receiving FAC will notice that their weekly payments will no longer include the \$25 FAC payments for weeks claimed after December 11, 2010.

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, signed by President Obama on February 17, 2009, created a temporary Federal Additional Compensation (FAC) program to provide for a weekly stimulus payment of \$25. FAC is payable to individuals who are entitled to receive regular unemployment insurance (UI), Extended Benefits (EB), federal Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08), and Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA).

The \$25 FAC payment was paid for weeks beginning February 22, 2009.

The FAC program ended on May 29, 2010. FAC eligibility must have been established by the week ending May 29, 2010 in order to continue receiving FAC payments through the week ending December 11, 2010 if otherwise eligible. No FAC benefits are payable after that date.
