Council Goals & Objectives:

The Alaska Safety Advisory Council was created by the Alaska Legislature to reduce accidents and health hazards to the citizens of Alaska. The Council accomplishes this by:

- Promoting positive safety and health activities and guidelines;
- Obtaining the cooperation of individuals, organizations and groups to support, promote and pursue good safety and health activities and guidelines;
- Coordinating safety matters with other State Departments;
- Making recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature; and,
- Sponsoring an annual Governor's Safety and Health Conference for the citizens of Alaska.

The Alaska Safety Advisory Council, in order to increase safety and health in the State of Alaska, will promote, advise, consult, encourage, coordinate and sponsor policies, activities and actions that are designed to reduce the loss of human and material resources in the State of Alaska.

Goal Statements:

- Plan, organize and promote the Annual Governor's Safety and Health Conference and Exhibition;
- Recognize the outstanding achievements of citizen's organizations, companies, political subdivisions and/or labor organizations contributing to producing a safer and healthier Alaska and advertise these accomplishments through various communications;
- Develop special projects to provide safety and health information directly to the citizens of Alaska and likewise enhance the occupational safety and health activities of the employers of the State;
- Develop a budget for planned disbursements and revenues;
- Review safety and health related legislation;
- Provide an annual report to the Commissioner of Labor at the end of the fiscal year to reflect ASAC accomplishments in fulfilling its objectives;

- Further the awareness of ASAC and its activities to the State citizenry;
- Schedule three member meetings during the fiscal year.
