**Program Description, Cost and Length****Massage Therapy**

Massage Therapy includes the following 4 courses held on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm for 33 weeks.

1. Anatomy
2. Physiology
3. Ethics and Business Practices
4. Massage Techniques

Cost: \$9150 + \$230 books + \$70 uniform tops + \$45 massage sheets

Length: 750 Hours (May be completed in 10 months, 14 months, or up to 3 years)

**Oriental Healing Massage**

Oriental Healing Massage includes all of the above courses for Massage Therapy, and the following additional 6 courses. The additional courses are held on Tuesday and Thursday mornings for a total of 24 weeks. These classes are advanced education for currently licensed health care practitioners available at an adjusted tuition rate. Licensed Massage Therapists that successfully complete these courses will receive a Certificate of Completion for Oriental Healing Massage.

1. Meridians and Points I (Taoist 12-Meridian Meditation)
2. Meridians and Points 2 (Point Categories and Combinations)
3. Oriental Medicine Theory I (Physiology)
4. Oriental Medicine Theory 2 (Energetic Diagnosis)
5. Introduction to Tui-Na Massage
6. Introduction to Thai Massage 36 course hours

Cost: \$7,200 + \$140 fee for laundry service

Length: 24 weeks

**Traditional Taoist Medical QiGong Practitioner****Level 1: Foundations in Oriental Medicine and Taoist Philosophy**

The student will begin to read, discuss, and understand Taoist Philosophy classics such as the "Tao Te Ching", "Secret of the Golden Flower" and "Opening the Dragon Gate". Various meditations and qigong exercises will be taught and practiced. Students will go through the first 13 chapters of the text "Chinese Medical QiGong Therapy: A Comprehensive Clinical Text" by Dr. Jerry Alan Johnson, Ph.D., DTCM, DMQ (China).

Cost: \$1,500 or \$1,700 by payment plan + texts

Length: 36 weeks

**Level 2: QiGong Healing Principles and Practices of Self-Cultivation**

The student will continue to read, discuss, and understand more Taoist Philosophy classics such as the "Secrets of Chinese Meditation" and "The Taoist Body". The main focus of the course will be in-class practice of various meditations and qigong exercises. Students will go through chapters 14 – 19, and 38-42 of the text "Chinese Medical QiGong Therapy: A Comprehensive Clinical Text" by Dr. Jerry Alan Johnson, Ph.D., DTCM, DMQ (China).

Additional course requirement: Taoist Herbology Level 1

Cost: \$1,500 or \$1,700 by payment plan + texts
