Case: UNOCAL Corporation vs. Paul D. Pietro, Alaska Workers' Comp. App. Comm'n Dec. No. 170 (September 26, 2012)

The Alaska Supreme Court (supreme court) granted review and reversed the commission's decision that the board abused its discretion in not holding another evidentiary hearing.

Dec. No. 178 (March 19, 2013) decided the remaining issues after the supreme court's reversal of Dec. No. 170. Dec. No. 082 (June 26, 2008) considered whether the commission had jurisdiction in an appeal of earlier board decisions that denied the compensability of Pietro's claims.
