This program directive is formal notice that Alaska OSH is implementing OSHA's Final Rule on the Tracking of Workplace Injuries and Illnesses, 29 CFR Part 1904, published in the January 25, 2019 Federal Register that went into effect February 25, 2019. As amended, these changes have been automatically adopted under 8 AAC 61,1010(a).

This program directive went into effect February 25, 2019 and cancels PD 10-07. Please ensure that all members of your staff receive this program directive, and understand how to implement it.
