- 1. <u>Purpose:</u> The Purpose of AKOSH Program Directive 93-3 is to revise the Technical Manual. It deletes and reserves Chapter 13 and adds Chapter 15, "Metric System Conversion", Chapter 16, "Polymer Matrix Materials: Advanced Composites", Chapter 17, "Laser Hazards", and Chapter 18, "Industrial Robots and Robot System Safety".
- 2. <u>Directives Affected:</u> DOSH Program Directive 90-4, OSHA Technical Manual, dated April 4, 1990.
- Background: AKOSH adopted the OSHA Technical Manual on April 4, 1990. The Alaska Technical Manual is identical to the OSHA Technical Manual except for changes to state references and the state's administrative organization. The Technical Manual provides guidelines to all AKOSH field staff, industrial hygienists, safety compliance officers, and safety and health consultants. All field staff, therefore, should have access to a copy of the Technical Manual to use as a reference.
- 4. Action: Update the Technical Manual by deleting Chapter 13 and by adding Chapters 15-18. Also replace the "Contents" pages.
